




PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads









FIT TABLE LEGS

Prepare product as per page 2:

Position table top upside down on a soft level surface IE: Floor with clean carpet or thick blanket on harder surface. Note 2 people will be required thru most of the assembly.

When table top [1] is in position take note of the thread holes in base, you will note a grouping of 3 threaded holes in a triangle pattern and a single threaded hole to right of the triangle of holes. The single threaded hole is to be used to attach the X table leg [3], you will note that the two single threaded holes are diagonally positioned.


Step 1: Take X table Leg [3] and aline with the thread holes described above, while second person holds table leg, take bolt [A] with spring washer [B] insert thru hole in table leg and into thread in hole, ensure you seat thread correctly, by hand turn 2-3 times or until you feel bolt has grip thread, do not tighten yet, now fit bolt as above on other side of X table leg. Once both bolts are seated correctly, take Allen Key [C] and tighten both bolts until firm.

Warning over tightening may cause damage to fitting.

Step 2: To fit other table legs [2] ensure you have leg facing away from centre of table top as indicated in drawing below. Aline all three holes in table leg with three threaded holes in table top.

While second person hold in position, table bolt [A] with spring washer and fit in same method as above. Again do not tighten bolts until you have all three bolts properly seated. Once all seated take Allen Key [C] and tighten until firm. Do not over tighten.

Repeat for second table leg [2]. Assembly complete. Move to next page

STEP 2: STAND TABLE ON LEGS

Please note this is a very heavy item and will require 2 reasonably strong people to pick up and place into position.

One person at each end looking down the length of the table. Please get a good grip and lift table using your knees straight up into air, now carefully in mid air rotate table over until feet can touch the floor. Do not lay table on its side to rotate onto feet as you may damage fittings.

To place table in position please move around table until you are mid way the length of table. Pick up form middle and place table in area to be used.

Warning never drag table always lift as above and with the help of another person. Dragging can cause damage to product and or your floor surface.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

About ceramic material:

Ceramics are generally made by taking mixtures of clay, earthen elements, powders, and water and shaping them into desired forms. Once the ceramic has been shaped, it is fired in a high temperature oven known as a kiln. In general, they are hard, corrosion-resistant and have a higher scratch resistance than glass.

Care Instructions for unglazed ceramic:

To reduce cleaning the use of table clothes and placemats is highly recommend. Please choose a pH neutral cleaner follow directions on packaging of product for use. Ensure you remove excess cleaning product and avoid spills onto other items.

Lacquer painted MDF:

No polishing is required for lacquer simply wipe down with a soft clean cloth, recommended to use a suitable microfiber cloth. For spills and grime build up please use a pH neutral cleaner. Ensure you remove excess cleaning product and avoid spills onto other items.

Metal lacquer painted brushed steel:

Legs are made up of a sturdy steel tube which has been scuffed up to add character. No polishing is required for lacquer surface on metal, simply keep dust free by using a soft clean cloth, recommended to use a suitable microfiber cloth. For spills and grime build up please use a pH neutral cleaner. Ensure you remove excess cleaning product and avoid spills onto other items.

- place very hot or cold items on the table surface unless adequately thick table mats are used to prevent such items coming in contact with the surface
- scratch the surface or using as a chopping surface
- allow children to play under tables
- Never drag table always move by lifting
- Clean only as per instructions on previous page. Do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives that may potentially scratch the surface

CHAIRS AND STOOLS

- Do not:
- Use chair/stool as a ladder
- Climb on the chair/stool
- Stand on the foot-rest of the chair, as this could lead to the stool becoming unbalanced and overturning
