

Indoor Dining & Occasional Care & Maintenance Guide

Verities of materials are used in construction of "Phoenix" furniture range, Such as Stainless Steel; Chrome plated steel, PU synthetic fabric & timber veneer. All will require maintenance to extend the life of finishes and general appearance.

Maintenance & Cleaning:

- PU synthetic fibre; Vacuum regularly with a soft brush attachment to remove dust and grit, & or wipe with a soft colourfast cloth dampened with plain water. This should be done as often as necessary or at least every 2 weeks. Do not rub excessively. Special note salts and body oils which occur naturally in human skin can damage the surface of the PU if left unclean for lengthy periods. In areas of high humidity more frequent cleaning will be required once a week. Deterioration may also occur thru contact with other chemical such as hair spray, gel mousse, perfume, deodorants, dye transference form clothing & some medication.
- Timber Veneer; Timber is protected by a coating of polyurethane coating; requirement is regular dusting; wipe over with a soft colourfast cloth dampened with plain water, dry with soft clean cloth. To avoid damage to surface cover with a table cloth & use solid placemats. Avoid dropping Sharpe objects as this may cause damage to surface. Microfiber cleaning cloths are highly recommended for use in this product.
- Stainless Steel & chromed steel; Routine cleaning can be accomplished by using warm water and a cloth. This is the least risky option for cleaning stainless steel, and honestly just plain water works to clean in most situations. Dry with a towel or cloth to prevent water spots. This is really important since minerals in water can leave marks on stainless steel. Wipe in the directions of the polish lines for best and most beautiful results. Microfiber cleaning cloths can be a great option to use when cleaning stainless steel because they do a great job of absorbing all of the water without scratching the surface.
- Fittings: Bolts, nuts & screws should be checked periodically to ensure still firm
- DO NOT: Drag furniture, always with the help of another person lift and place, to avoid damage to floor surface & or component fitting.
- DO NOT: Pull loose thread, cut them instead.
- DO NOT: Use detergents, solvent or abrasives on any components on product.
- DO NOT: Place product within 50cm of heat source IE: heater, open fire.
- DO NOT: Place product in direct sunlight or near powerful lamps.
- DO NOT: Jump, flop or stand on furniture.
- DO NOT: Leave beverage spills or food on furniture clean off immediately.
- Always use Place mats when eating or drinking at Furniture.

In summary indoor furniture products require care to provide you with many years of use. Best results are to combine maintenance and protection when in use.
