



## **PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION**

### Before you start:

- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads





Assemble the backrest cushion and seat cushion with bolt A. Use bolt E to assemble footstool Base(6) and Cwoods for footstool(5) and then the bolt C to footstool Cushion(4).





# Care Instruction for leather covering

#### **Regular Care:**

Vacuum & or brush away dust & grit as necessary, wipe with a soft clean dye fast cloth. Wipe excess liquid up immediately with a absorbent cloth or sponge.

#### **Periodic Cleaning:**

Every 3-4 months remove excess body oils with a leather cleaner, followed by application of leather protector. Follow direction as recommended. Frequency of periodic care depends on usage.

#### Notes:

Accumulation of perspiration and body oils on arm pads, headrest etc. may damage your Leather in these areas and will require more frequent cleaning.

Leather is not resistant to animals. Claws scratch covering, saliva is acidic and can damage finish.

Alcohol, hair spray, gel mousse, perfume, deodorants, some medication and dye penetration from cloths can have adverse effects on surface of leather.

## Care Instruction for chair & mechanism

Every 3-4 months lay chair over on its back and wipe and or vacuum action inside chair to remove excess dust and fluff, pay special attention to swivel action at base of chair, ensure all metal components are clean and free of impediments.

Ensure all bolts are firm refer to assembly instructions for location.

#### Important safety instructions:

Do not sit on arms

Do not stand on chair

Do not lean on back of chair

Do not drag chair always lift with the help of another person

Do not allow items to be entangled with mechanism IE: Blankets, pillows & clothing

Ensure swivel mechanism on chair base is clear of loose threads, long carpet fibre's or simular items
