**Your furniture purchase is an investment.**

**Here are a few tips to maximize the lifetime of your furniture with a minimum amount of effort. Properly caring for your furniture can help ensure that it looks great year after year.**

### Wood Furniture Maintenance:

Always dust, wipe, and clean with the grain of the wood. Dust with a soft clean cloth. Dust will scratch the furniture surface if not removed properly. If a polished surface becomes foggy, rub it with a cloth dipped in a solution of one tablespoon vinegar to one litre of water. Rub softly with the grain until the surface is completely dry. Soap and water are not advisable for wood surface. Water can penetrate the finish and raise the grain on wood, causing damage.

### The Enemies of Wood:

Moisture is wood's worst enemy.

Liquid spills should be gently wiped up immediately. Coasters should be used under all beverages. Do not allow rubber or vinyl materials to lie on the furniture.

Chemicals in rubber may leave a stain. Put a strip of felt or leather under accessories that have rubber or vinyl. Heat creates a chemical change in the furniture's finish, which results in a white spot.

Use protective pads under hot dishes, appliances, etc. Sunlight's ultraviolet rays can damage the finish of furniture. Do not place furniture directly against a heater or radiator and do not place in the path of hot streams of air from central heating. This will cause extreme localized drying of the wood.

### Iron Work Maintenance:

Keep dust free; Bolts and screws must be checked and re-tightened as necessary or minimum every 6 months. Paint chips should be touched up as they occur. When bare metal is exposed to environment, metal will first oxidize and next stage will be rust, causing structural integrity to be compromised.

### The Enemies Iron Work:

All iron or steel products are painted to protect metal from the elements.

Do not immerse in water. Liquid spills should be cleaned off immediately. Alcohol, fruit juice etc are acidic and can cause paint finish to change colour. When cleaning please use only Ph neutral products.

USE GLASS CLEANERS ON FINISHED SURFACES. AMMONIA WILL CHEMICALLY ATTACK THE FINISH.

DO NOT WRITE DIRECTLY ON SURFACE

### NEVER

## PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

### Avoid use of powered/battery drills.

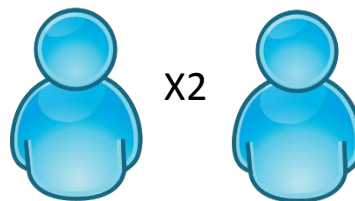
Improper use of drills can irreversible damage fittings.

### Before you start:

1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
4. **Ensure to check all components for any damage before assembly.** Please report any damage found to below, if possible forward images of component to below
5. **Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.**
6. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
7. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads

### Important Advice:

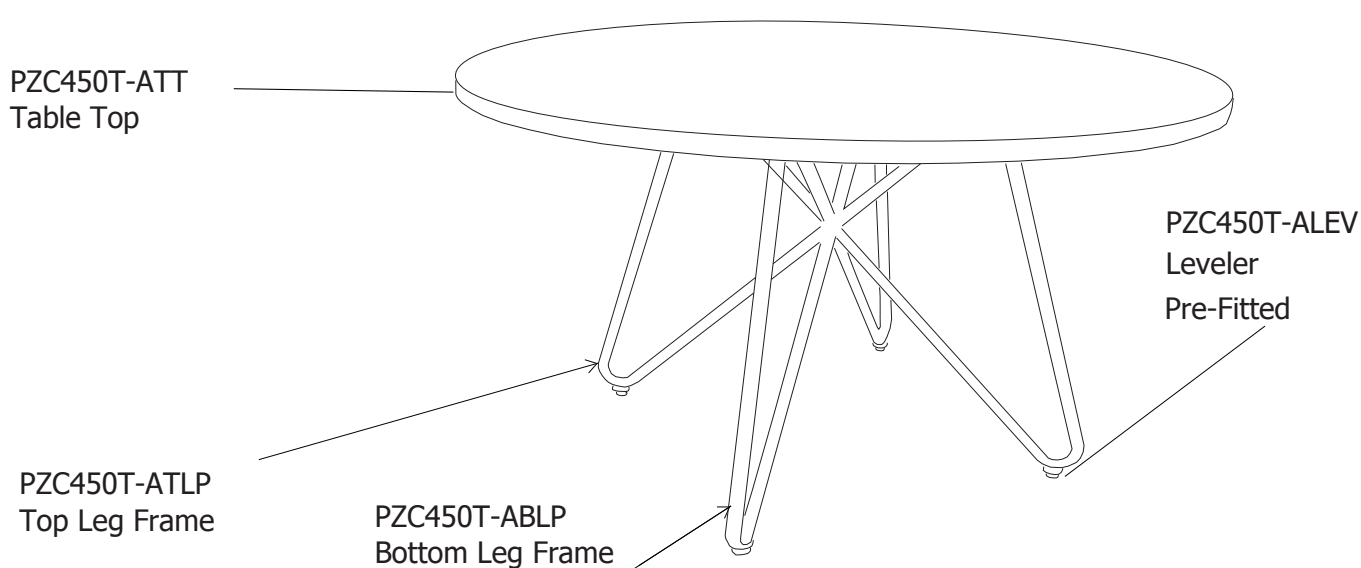
Never place hot or cold items on surface without proper insulation. Always use place mats and drink coasters. Always clean up spills immediatly. Standing or sittting on table can cause harm to yourself as well as your furniture. Never drag table always lift to move, a second person will be required.

# Assembly Instructions

\* Do not tighten screws & bolts until the entire item is completely assembled.

## STEP 1

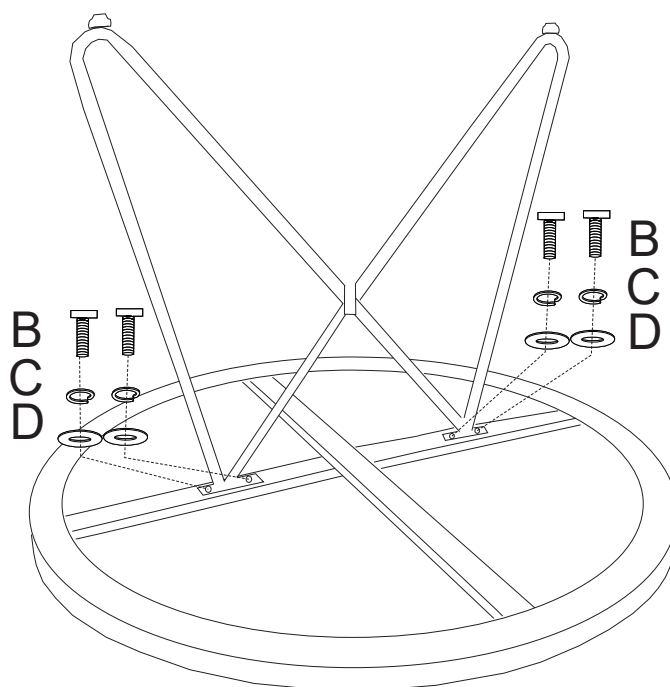
Please arrange table top as shown in diagram. Ensure the surface is level, clean and soft. Suggest a clean blanket or similar.

Please identify the top leg.

At the junction of the two legs one will have a hole all the way thru and other will have threading and block end.

Top leg is threaded model.

As shown in diagram Aline hole in top leg with threaded holes in table top, then take bolt [B] add spring washer [C] also add flat washer [D]. Insert thru hole as shown, then by hand seat thread correctly, turn 2-3 times and check bolt has gripped and is square. Repeat for other 3 bolts. You may at this stage take up the slack and tighten bolts until they are finger tight only. Move 2 Step 2.



## STEP 2

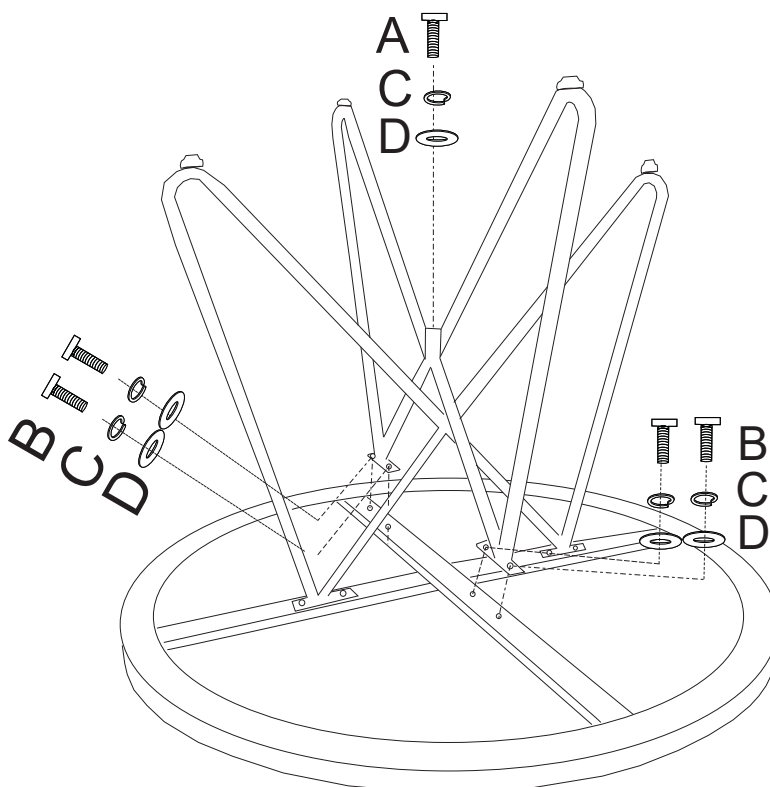
Next take bottom leg and link the two junctions as shown.

Take bolt [A] add spring washer [C] then add flat washer [D]. Insert bolt into hole at junction, ensure to seat thread correctly by turn by hand 2-3 times. Check bolt has gripped.

Next Aline the holes in bottom leg as in step one and proceed to add bolts and washer as previously instructed.

Now all bolts are fitted correctly, do a visual check all pieces are square and aligned properly take tool provided [E] and start to tighten bolts. Please start with the bolt at junction of legs. Note do not over tighten as you may inadvertently cause damage to fittings.

Now with the help of a second person lift table into the air and rotate mid air until you can place table on all four feet at the same time.

- Never drag table always move by lifting
- Clean only as per instructions on previous page. Do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives that may potentially scratch the surface

#### CHAIRS AND STOOLS

- **Do not:**
- Use chair/stool as a ladder
- Climb on the chair/stool
- Stand on the foot-rest of the chair, as this could lead to the stool becoming unbalanced and overturning
