


Electrical Risk


Carefully plan your positioning of recliner

3. Keep cords away from heat sources





Step
1



Locate the metal bars at back of chair base. Now with the help of a second person. Take backrest and align metal sockets with bars in chair base, then in unison slide chair back down metal bars. Double check both metal bars and metal sockets are aligned correctly. Then make sure both side are pushed down and level.

Please note wings are left and right. Please ensure you fit correct one on each side. Ensure that inner bracket is lined up outer bracket before you slide together.



Please confirm the left and right armrest bag. Then locate the zipper on chair base. Align zipper and gently zip up. Next on the opposite side of armrest you will see Velcro. Locate partner of Velcro on inside arm of chair base and attach. Ensure you do not have any bubble in Velcro.

Lift Chair Electrical How to Operate



Plug & Play:
 Power Plug and Cord located at back of chair base.
 Hand controller located in pocket on side of chair base.


Ensure there are no tangles in cord before you plug in.

To Stand chair up:
 Press and hold Close/Stand up button:

 Button Marked CLOSE: Operates Lift chair options



PRODUCT OPERATION - Reclining Action

HINTS & TIPS

Please note:
 Only start Reclining action when chair is in neutral position. Reclining action can not function if chair is in stand up position.

To Recline Chair:
 Press and hold Open button release when you reach desired position.

To Return Chair to Neutral:
 Press and hold Open button, take note if chair is not at maximum of it's cycle it will continue to recline till it reaches maximum position, continue to hold button and will start to reverse position.



Safety Warning and Advice

WARNING: *Basic information for all household members.*

- Do not allow children to play on the chair.
- Always leave the chair in an upright closed position.
- Keep hands and feet clear of the mechanism.
- Only the occupant should operate the chair.
- Small children and or pets in the house, please check under chair before lowering chair.
- Do not sit or lean on arms.
- Do not stand on chair.
- Do not drag chair always lift with the help of a second person.
- Do not allow items to be entangled with mechanism IE: Blankets, pillows and clothing.
- Please be aware that electricity flows from power point to transformer underneath chair, this should be treated with respect and any liquid spilled may cause problems with motor. Please switch off at power point and unplug until you clean up and check if any moisture has been spilled on motor or transformer before use. If concerned that liquid has affected above do not reconnect consult your local electrician for a safety check.

Advisory:

Care should be taken with placement of chair, below are some suggestion of things to avoid

- Ensure power cord is not used in a traffic area .
- Ensure power cord is not subject to any moisture.
- Do not place chair near any heat sources. Such as fire places, heaters and in direct line of air conditioning ducting.

General advice:

Please be advised that products are limited in design for residential use only and not suitable for commercial use.

Please be aware that coverings and finishing are not animal proof.

Claws can scratch covering and paint finishers.

Saliva is acidic and can damage finishings .

Chair is designed for the use of a single occupant. Do not double up.

Do not use chair as a ladder.

Do not jump or flop on chair.

Care and Maintenance

Varieties of materials are used in construction of "Lift Recliners" furniture range. All will require some form of maintenance to extend the life of finishes and general appearance. Please take the time to read below and follow advice to enhance life of your furniture.

Leather Covering: General

Keep dust free at all times.

Regularly use a damp soft clean cloth and wipe down leather.

Pay special attention to areas where skin come in contact with leather. IE: Armrest Pads, Headrest, front section of seat and top of footrest cushions.

Please clean up any spills immediately

Leather Covering:Periodic Leather cleaning

Every 3-4 months you will need to give leather a good clean to remove excess body oil.

Please purchase a propriety leather cleaner and follow directions listed on packaging.

You may also purchase a leather conditioner/protector to revitalize leather after a good clean.

Frequency of above cleaning can vary due to colour leather, use and environment.

A chair used one (1) hour a day will require less cleaning than a chair used eight (8) hours a day.

Environmental conditions such as areas with high humidity and low air quality again would require more frequent cleaning.

Leather Covering:Professional cleaning

Even the most diligent house keeper cannot always prevent leather from aging or looking tired.

We recommend you use the services of a reputable cleaning service . If and when your cleaning does not appear to have an affect.

Leather Covering: Enemies to leather finish

Body oils.

Chemicals used in hair spray, gel, mousse, perfume and deodorants.

Liquids such as alcohol and fruit juices.

Even some medications have an effect, as these can transfer though body oils.

Dye transference from some clothing. IE: Acid washed jeans.

Please factor above in your cleaning regime.

Chair base system: Underneath

Please remove dust and grit as required.

Every 3-4 months lay chair on it's side. Vacuum and wipe to remove excess dust and fluff, ensure all metal components are clean and free of impediments.

Warranty Detail

2 Year Warranty

A two (2) year warranty applies to product against any defect associated with faulty workmanship for a period of (2) years from date of purchase.

Furniture Solutions accepts no responsibility for defects caused by incorrect assembly, mishandling, acts of god, general wear & tear, stains from spills/vegetation, chipping/scratching, exposure to extreme heat/cold, mold/mildew, hardware corrosion, misuse of the products & defects caused by failure in duty of care for the product in accordance with the care instructions. Warranty only extends to original purchaser and is not transferable, except when given as a gift.
